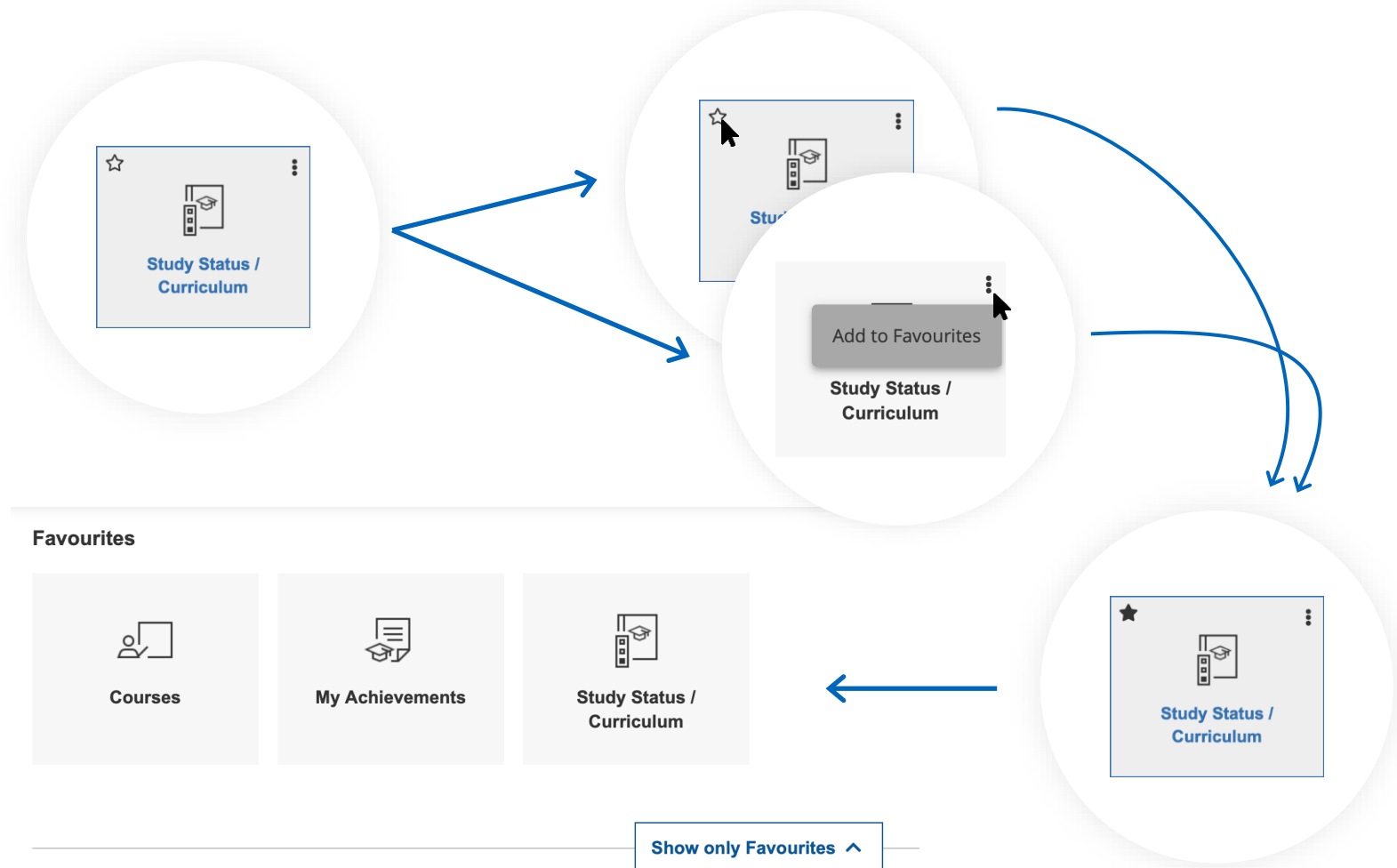

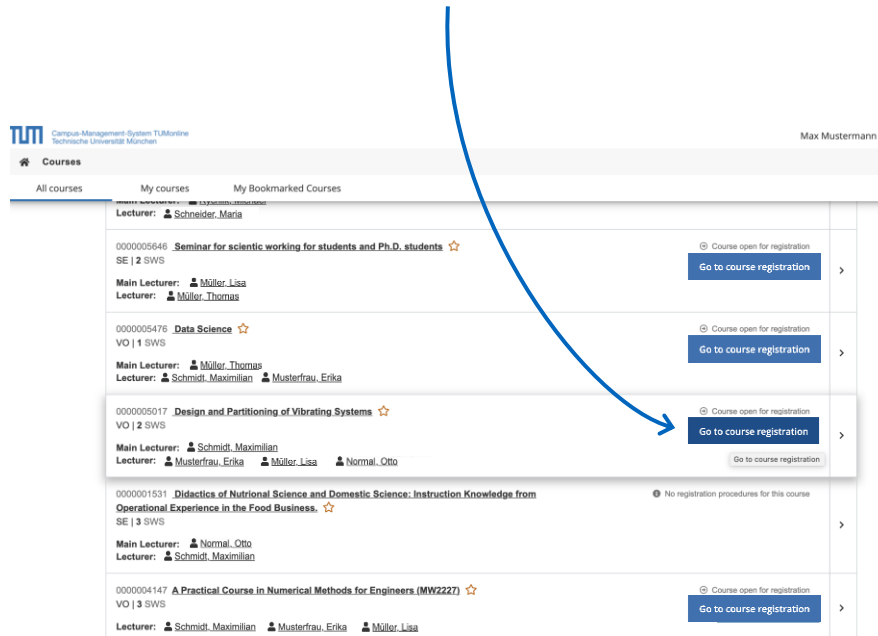

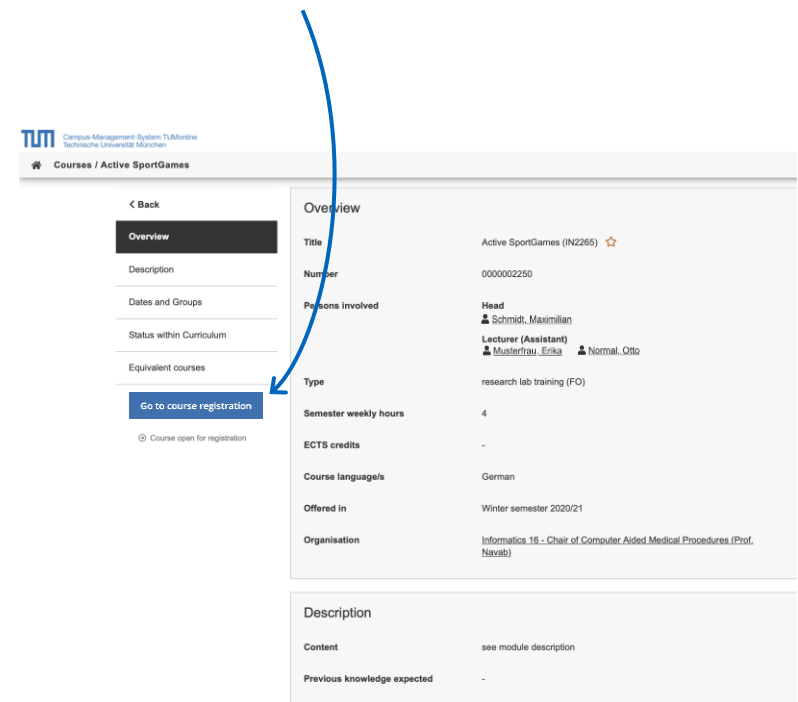

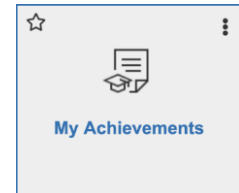

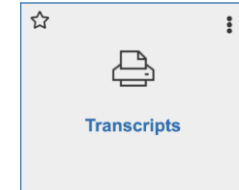

- In the settings you can choose if you want the course dates of your bookmarked courses to be displayed in your calendar as well.

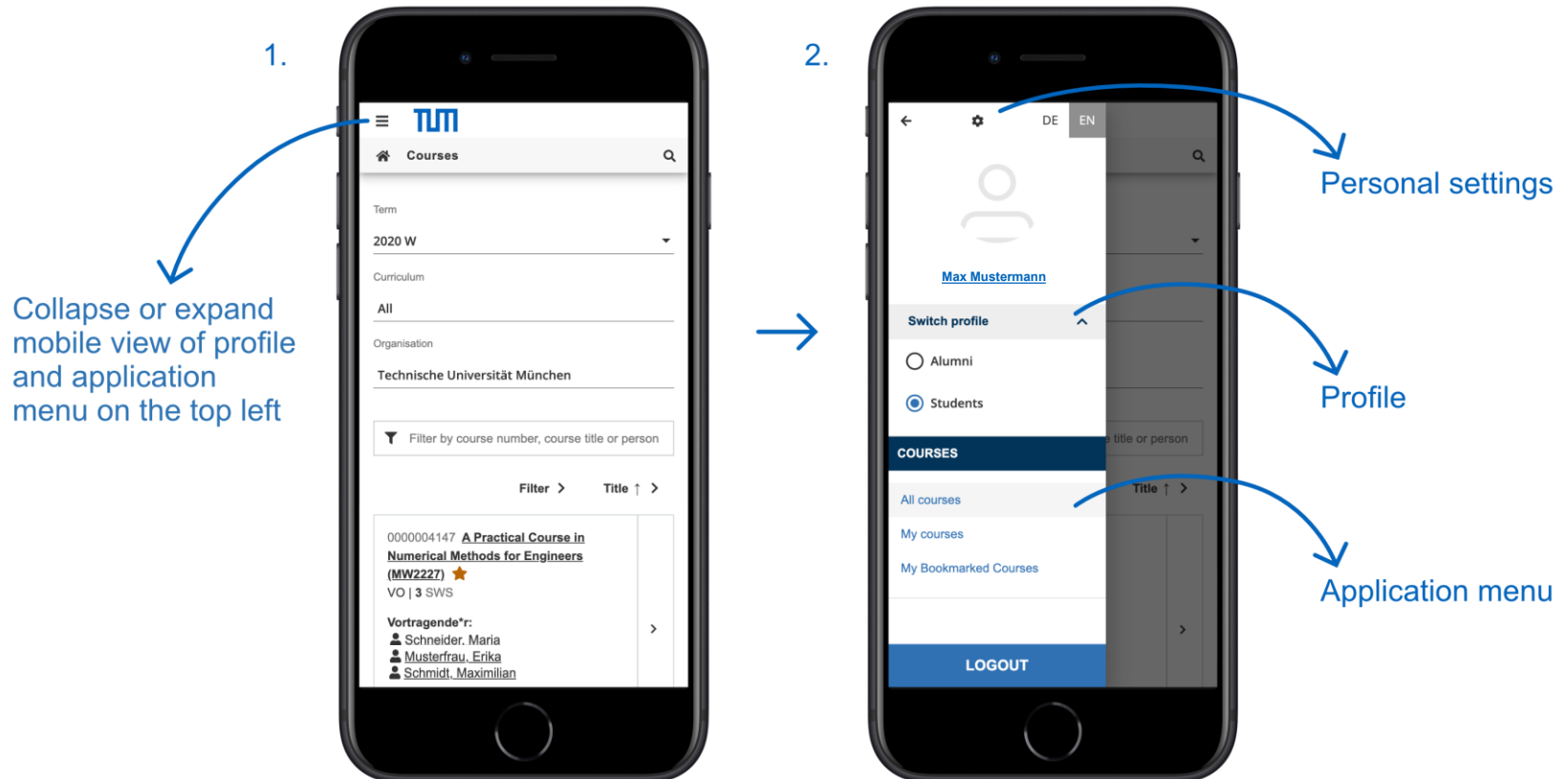
